

AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF SPOKANE (“CSS”) comprising Spokane Falls Community College and Spokane Community College and Temple University, Japan Campus (“TUJ”) enter into this Affiliation Agreement (“Agreement”), as of August 21, 2013 based on the two institutions’ commitment to promoting international education and to providing their students with access to attractive educational options. Specifically, it aims to facilitate the process of CCS students applying to study at TUJ.

Obligations of Temple University, Japan Campus

In consideration of the terms and conditions specified in this Agreement, TUJ agrees to perform the following:

1. To waive the Application Fee (currently ¥10,000) for students who have been enrolled at CCS within two years of submitting an application to TUJ.
2. To provide each CCS student with an admission decision within two-to-four weeks of the submission of a complete application, except in limited admissions blackout periods.
3. To ensure that qualified CCS students are considered for TUJ scholarships and other financial aid, prior to and after enrolling at TUJ.
4. To provide preferential access to home-stay and dormitory housing.
5. To consider a CCS-TUJ articulation agreement that indicates what CCS credits can be counted toward Temple University degrees.
6. To have an Admissions Counselor visit CCS at mutually agreeable times as well as provide CCS students with up-to-date information on TUJ’s academic programs, admissions criteria, visa issues, and other topics.
7. To designate one individual who will serve as TUJ’s CCS contact person. This individual’s responsibilities will include providing CCS with information and materials on TUJ, overseeing the management of applications from CCS students, and otherwise ensuring that TUJ fulfills its obligations specified in this Agreement.
8. To provide information about CCS to ESL students studying at TUJ who might be interested in studying at CCS, and to refer such students to CCS from time to time.

Obligations of COMMUNITY COLLEGES OF SPOKANE

In consideration of the terms and conditions specified in this Agreement, CCS agrees to perform the following:

1. To notify and advise CCS students of the opportunity to study at TUJ, including the benefits specified in this Agreement. This includes raising CCS students' awareness of TUJ through such means as posters, information sessions for interested groups/classes, individualized counseling, and other similar means.
2. To designate one individual who will serve as CCS's TUJ contact person. This individual's responsibilities will include providing information on TUJ to CCS students and coordinating visits to CCS by TUJ Admissions Counselors.

Both parties agree to only use the other institution's name and logo for purposes of implementing this Agreement only and upon prior approval of the other institution for each use.

Either institution may terminate this Agreement with three months' advance notice. This Agreement will be valid for a period two (2) years from the date of acceptance by CCS.

In the event that this Agreement is terminated, the benefits specified herein will still be extended to all CCS students who have already enrolled at, or been admitted to, TUJ.

This Agreement will take effect upon execution by both institutions.
